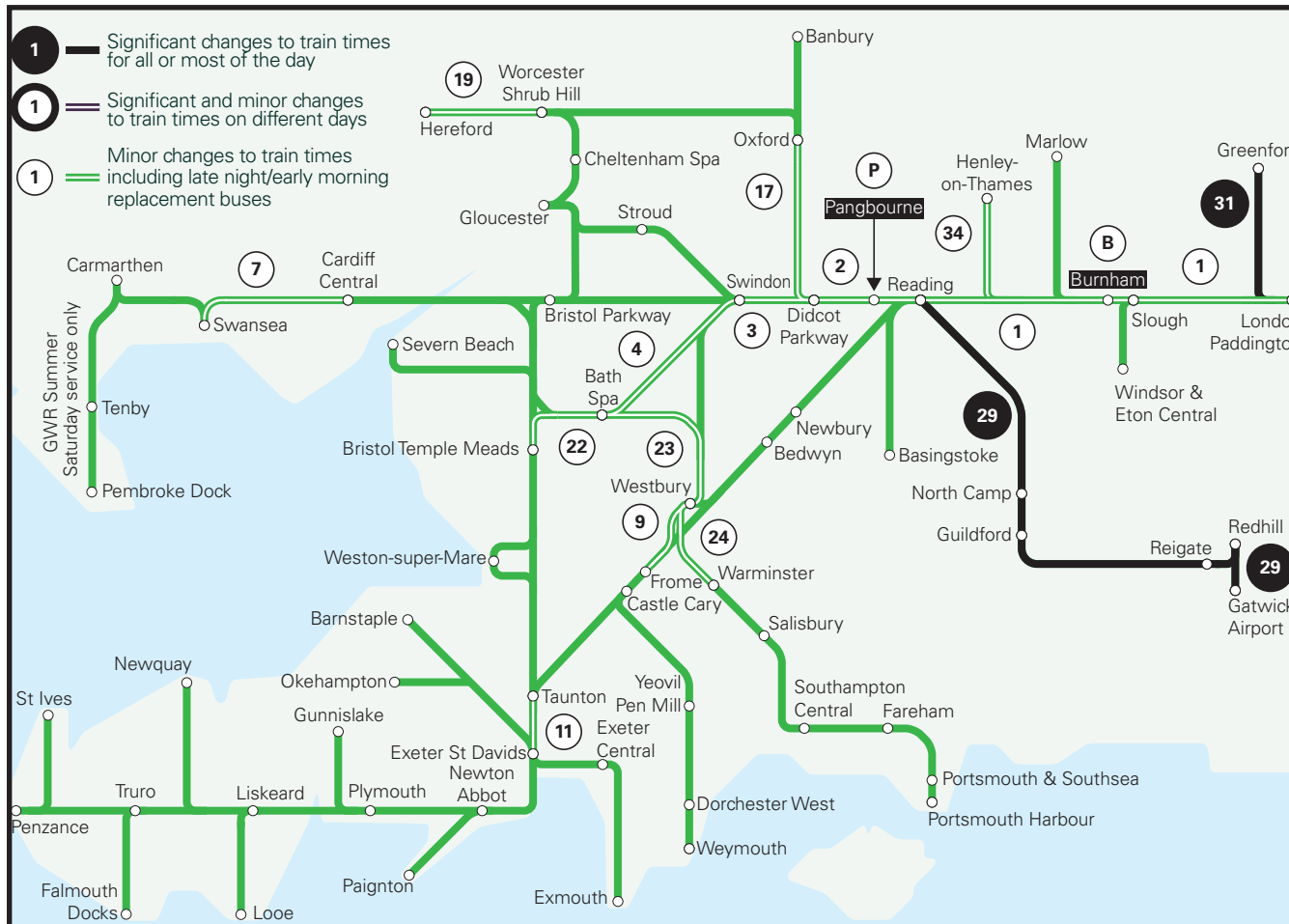


# Summary of timetable changes

- ① ③① **Saturday** - All day, trains between West Ealing and Greenford (including the 0543 London Paddington to Greenford and 2204 Greenford to London Paddington) will not run. Passengers should use alternative TfL bus and Tube services, on which valid GWR tickets will be accepted via reasonable routes.
- 
- ① ② ⑦ **Saturday** - The 2345 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington will terminate at Ealing Broadway. **Sunday** - The 0638 London Paddington to Reading will start from Ealing Broadway. TfL Central line connections will be available to / from central London.
- ① ② ⑦ **Sunday** - All day, services to and from London Paddington are subject to retimings for all or part of their journey. Some trains may depart EARLIER than usual. Most fast trains between London Paddington and Oxford will not run, but will be part replaced by additional trains running between Didcot Parkway and Oxford. Most trains between London Paddington and Swindon / Bristol Parkway / Cardiff Central will call additionally at Slough, Maidenhead and Twyford. Local stopping services between London Paddington, Reading and Didcot Parkway will run between Reading and Didcot Parkway only.

- ② ③ ④ ②② **Sunday** - The 2300 & 2333 London Paddington to Bristol Temple Meads will be diverted after Reading to run non-stop to Bath Spa, not calling at Didcot Parkway, Swindon or Chippenham. Passengers for Didcot Parkway should use an alternative local service from Reading. Replacement buses will run from Reading to Swindon and Chippenham.
- 
- ⑦ **Sunday** - The 2045 (departing 2037) & 2145 (departing 2203) London Paddington to Swansea will be diverted after Cardiff Central and arrive Bridgend and beyond up to 45 minutes later than usual.
- ⑦ **Monday to Thursday** - The 2048, 2148 & 2249 London Paddington to Swansea will be diverted after Cardiff Central and arrive Bridgend and beyond up to 25 minutes later than usual.
- 
- ⑨ ②② ②③ **Monday to Thursday** - The 2306 Bristol Temple Meads to Westbury and 2345 Bristol Temple Meads to Frome will terminate at Bath Spa. Replacement buses will run from Bath Spa to Westbury and Frome. The 2123 Portsmouth Harbour to Bristol Temple Meads will terminate at Westbury. A replacement bus will run from Westbury to Bath Spa, with a later rail connection from Bath Spa to Bristol Temple Meads.
- 
- ⑪ **Monday and Tuesday** - The 2348 Bristol Temple Meads to Exeter St Davids will arrive later at Exeter St Davids.
- 
- ①⑦ **Saturday from approximately 2230 until end of service** - Buses will replace trains between Didcot Parkway and Oxford. Some trains will be retimed.
- ①⑦ **Sunday** - The 0754 Oxford to London Paddington will start from Didcot Parkway. Passengers travelling from Oxford should use the next available service.
- 
- ①⑨ **Sunday until approximately 1800** - Buses will replace trains between Worcester Shrub Hill / Worcester Foregate Street, Great Malvern and Hereford.
- 
- ②④ **Sunday** - The 2230 Cardiff Central to Warminster will terminate at Westbury. A replacement bus will run from Westbury to Warminster.

**Sunday** - All day, buses will replace trains between Reading and North Camp. A reduced, hourly train service will run between Blackwater / North Camp, Guildford, Redhill and Gatwick Airport. Passengers should interchange between buses and trains at North Camp. In addition, the 0610 Reading to Gatwick Airport will start from Guildford. A replacement bus will run EARLIER from Reading to Guildford.

**Tuesday to Friday** - The 0018 Henley-on-Thames to Reading will terminate at Twyford. An alternative rail connection will be available from Twyford to Reading.

***The following GWR trains will not call at Burnham or Taplow:***

**Saturday** - 2345 Didcot Parkway to Slough;

**Sunday** - 0034 London Paddington to Reading;

**Tuesday to Friday** - 0002 & 0045 London Paddington to Reading and 0019 Reading to London Paddington;

In all cases, replacement buses will run between Slough, Burnham and Taplow.

***The following GWR trains will not call at Burnham: Sunday*** - 0649 Ealing Broadway to Reading, 0636 & 0742 Reading to London Paddington, 2331 London Paddington to Didcot Parkway and 2353 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington.

Replacement buses will run between Slough and Burnham.

***The following trains will not call at Pangbourne: Monday to Wednesday*** - 2236 & 2334 London Paddington to Didcot Parkway and 2324 Didcot Parkway to London Paddington; ***Tuesday to Thursday*** - 0355 Oxford to Reading (no replacement transport provided);

**Friday** - 2334 London Paddington to Didcot Parkway.

Unless otherwise shown, replacement buses will run between Pangbourne and Tilehurst.
